The quiz was named as Prof. Brahm Prakash Memorial Materials Quiz (BPMMQ) in 1993, in honour of India's illustrious metallurgist. Since then, the BPMMQ has evolved into a premier nationwide event, attracting over 120 students annually.

Join us at Kalpakkam this year during Sep. 18-19, 2026 for BPMMQ -2026, where you will not only challenge your knowledge but also get an exclusive glimpse of nuclear reactors and research facilities.

Metal Camp (Sept. 18, 2026)

During BPMMQ-2026, students will also participate in the Metal Camp, an exciting visit to various iconic facilities such as the Fast Breeder Test Reactor (FBTR) and associated research facilities. This immersive visit will be an invaluable experience for aspiring scientists, offering firsthand insights into the working of nuclear reactors and the forefront of research in materials science.

Quiz programme (Sept. 19, 2026)

- Each team shall consist of **two students** of class XI and XII only.
- Maximum **three teams** are allowed per chapter. Only **one escort** per chapter is allowed to accompany the students.
- The confirmation of the participation and number of teams shall be sent to **bpmmqkalpakkam@gmail.com**.
- Online registration forms along with the details of participants /escorts, scan copy of ID cards (preferably Aadhar) and travel itinerary shall be submitted by IIM Chapter Representatives not later than **Aug. 25, 2026**.

Essay & elocution contest

BPMMQ-2026 features an Essay and Elocution contest, **open only for quiz participants**. BPMMQ-2026 quiz participants are invited to express their innovative views and ideas on one of the following topics:

- **Developing a circular economy for materials in India**
- **Beyond lithium: Batteries of the future**
- **Rare-earth metals: Significance and Indian Scenario**

The soft copy of the essay **must be forwarded only by the respective chapter** through email to **bpmmqkalpakkam@gmail.com** on or before **Sept. 05, 2026**.

Essay Format: Shared at www.bpmmq.in/essay

Evaluation: Essays will be assessed, among other criteria, for originality, comprehensiveness of coverage of topic and novel ideas presented. To qualify, essays must pass plagiarism checks (>10% will be disqualified).

Elocution Contest: A total of **8 best essays** selected by the jury will be invited for the elocution contest on **Sept. 18, 2026**.

Awards

The winner team and runner-up team of **BPMMQ-2026** will receive the **Awards** with prize money of Rs. **15,000/-** and Rs. **10,000/-** respectively at valedictory function of BPMMQ-2025 in Kalpakkam on **Sep. 19, 2026**, and the remainder at the IIM Awards Ceremony during IIM Annual Technical Meeting, 2026.

Additionally, all the finalists will receive exciting gifts.

The winner and two runners-up of **elocution contest** will receive a cash prize of Rs. **10,000/-** and Rs. **5,000/-** respectively.
